Accessing your COVID-19 Vaccination Certificate

We have had a very generous offer from member **Joanne Mulvaney** to assist those wishing to set up a **MyGov account** & link it to **Medicare** so they can access their **COVID-19 Vaccination Certificate** immediately.

This is how it works.

1. Personal information required.
 - Email address (Joanne can help set one up if needed)
 - Your MyGov password (if you have previously set up a MyGov account)
 - Mobile Phone
 - Medicare Card
 - Bank Account details (for Medicare refunds)
 - Date of Birth
 - Address
2. Contact Joanne either via:
 - a. Text message (this is her preferred method)
 - b. Mobile 0400 298 190
 - c. Email jakjor2008@hotmail.com
3. The one-on-one session will be conducted at the **Senior Citizens**

Centre at these times. Contact Joanne to arrange an appointment.

- a. Tuesday — Between 2:00 and 4:00 pm
- b. Wednesday — 9:00 am to 12 noon and 2:00 – 4:00 pm
- c. Friday — 9:00 am to 12 noon and 2:00 – 4:00 pm

Joanne will also be able to **print out your Certificate** using the printer at the Centre.

This is a free-of-charge service and Alpine U3A thanks Joanne for her offer.

- Please have your **Medicare Card** available.
