Gabriel Gaté trained as a chef with several of the best French chefs of his generation in several of the top restaurants in France and England.

He arrived in Australia in 1977 with his Australian wife, Angie. Soon after, Gabriel began to freelance as a chef consultant, cooking

He is one of Australia's best-selling cookery authors, his 24 cookbooks having sold well over one million copies. His latest book is So French So Sweet.

Gabriel has presented cookery shows on television for the last 40 years. His credits include 'The Good Food Show' (ABC) and 'What's Cooking?' (Nine Network)

More recently and for fifteen years Gabriel has produced and fronted the popular cooking segment, 'Taste Le Tour with Gabriel Gaté' for SBS TV, featuring the most talented chefs and patissiers, the best food, wines and gastronomy of France.

Several generations of chefs and home cooks have been inspired by Gabriel's cooking and food philosophy, and he is often referred to as the original TV Master Chef in Australia.

On Bastille Day 2000, the French government honoured Gabriel for his contribution to French gastronomy with the Chevalier dans l'ordre du mérite agricole medal.

He will describe how the landscape inspires and offers some of the most delectable ingredients such as game, cheeses, seafood, fungi and berries etc.
